1. Admission Counseling: 13.06.2019

We have received more than 1500 applications for 470 seats for this academic year and admitted the students through offline counseling, as per the guidelines given by Telangana State Council of Higher Education and also Osmania University.

3. Welcome to First year students: 01.07.2019

An Induction Program for the First year Students was arranged by the college in the Vasavi Kalyana Mantapam. Our Secretary & Correspondent, Chairman, Former Principal, Principal and Vice-Principals graced the occasion. All the UG first year students with their parents attended the program. College Principal Sri.K.Raghu Veer and other dignitaries explained the students, about the policies of the college, its rules and also introduced all the Staff members. College Chairman Prof.V.Vishwanadham advised the students to work hard and pursue the studies in a systematic manner, so that the students can become responsible citizens of the country.

4. Orientation on PMS: 03.07.2019

An Orientation program was organized by Ujwala committee on Symptoms and Remedies during Pre Menstrual Syndrome. One of the famous Gynecologists in twin cities, Dr. B. Vijaya Lakshmi, addressed the women folk in the auditorium. She explained the causes that, most women have at least two signs of PMS each month. But it's not the same for everyone. PMS is a group of changes that can effect on many levels. They can be physical, emotional, or behavioral. The changes come 1 to 2 weeks before the period. PMS shows up in different ways. But most women get **Physical signs such as** bloated tummy, Headache, Joint pains, Pimples, Weight gain etc. and **Emotional signs such as** tense or anxiousness, Depression, Crying, Mood swings, Cannot sleep, Do not want to be with people, Feel overwhelmed or out of control and sometimes angry outbursts. The resource person suggested some allopathic as well as natural home remedies to get through the problem.

5. Wipro Pool drive: 05.07.2019.

Wipro pool drive was conducted, where 45 students of our college and 11 students from other colleges participated in the online test. Two students got selected in the Final round, which was held on 30th July 2019 through video conference.

6. Event Management & ACCA: 08.07.2019.

An Orientation program on Event management & ACCA was organized for the First year students of all the streams. The Speakers from Rachnoustav Academy motivated the students to take up the Event management Certificate course, as it has bright future prospects. Event Management basically means any service offered to the consumers that contain planning, advertising or presentation of different events. The Speaker also enlightened the gathering on ACCA and its importance.

7. ABHYAS: 12.07.2019 – 17.07.2019.

A training program for the Supporting Staff was organized by the Department of English. The Faculty members of the department have started teaching Alphabet, as it is the foundation for reading and writing. All the Staff members have shown interest in learning the Alphabets by practicing them in oral as well as written form.
