It works by emitting an electromagnetic field of radiation within its range, and the presence of a physical object in the proximity is detected and returned to the sensor.

Drone Technology: A drone refers to an aerial vehicle that receives remote commands from a pilot or relies on software for autonomous flight. Many drones display features like cameras for collecting visual data and propellers for stabilizing their flight patterns.
