FEEDBACK ANALYSIS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-19

Students Satisfaction Survey

Total 100 students participated in the survey from all the disciplines.

- 72% students agreed that 55-100% of syllabus is covered in the class.
- 83% students opined that teachers' preparation for the class is satisfactory.
- 85% students agreed that teacher's communication is effective.
- 84% students opined that teaching methodology is good.
- 67% students are of the opinion that internal evaluation process done by the teachers is usually fair.
- 50% students opined that their performance in assignments is discussed occasionally.
- 56% students opined that institution rarely takes interest in promoting internships and field trips.
- 73% students agreed that teaching and mentoring process in the college is moderately facilitated in cognitive, social and emotional growth.
- 65% students agreed that college provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.
- 79% students opined that teachers occasionally informs about expected competencies, course outcomes and programmed outcomes.
- 76% pupils opined that the mentors usually provide task guidance.
- 85% students opined that the teachers illustrate concepts through examples and applications.
- 64% students are of the opinion that teachers partially encourage them in facing challenges.
- 49% students opined that the teachers rarely identify their weaknesses and help in overcoming them.
- 61% of the pupils agreed that institution/teachers use student centric methods.
- 76% students agreed that the teachers encourage them in participating extracurricular activities.
- 81% students are of opinion that teachers make students to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills.
- Students opined that 50-69% of the teacher's use of ICT tools.
- 76% students rated that the teaching-learning process in the institution is good.
- 83% students agreed that the faculty take classes regularly.
- 76% students agreed that the institution made alternative arrangement of the classes in the absence of any faculty.
- 68% students strongly agreed that the faculty is available beyond the normal class timings.

Recruiters Feedback Analysis

A questionnaire is prepared and feedback is collected from the employers who visited the campus for recruitment process.

- 100% recruiters accepted that the faculty and volunteers are cooperative.
- 66.6% of the recruiters told that the infrastructural requirements of the college are satisfactory.
- 100% recruiters accepted that the students of the college are punctual.
- 100% recruiters opined that the competence levels of students are satisfactory.
- 100% recruiters accepted that the Resumes of students are professional.
- All the recruiters informed that the communication skills of the students are highly satisfied.
- All the recruiters agreed that the students' etiquette is very good.

Teachers Feedback Analysis

A questionnaire is prepared and circulated to the faculty of the college. Total 44 responses received which were used for the analysis.

• 93.18% of the faculty opined that the Vision of the college is aptly fulfilled.

- 90.9% agreed that the students maintain discipline in the campus.
- 97.7% of the teachers strongly agreed that there is continuous professional development for the staff is provided by the institution.
- 95.5% of the faculty opined that every member is getting equal opportunity.
- 81.8% teachers mentioned that medical facilities are provided by the college.
- 93.18% agreed that hygiene is maintained in the institution.
- 95.5% have agreed that clean drinking water is provided to all in the college.
- 100% of the teachers are utilizing the library facilities.
- 95.5% of the faculty is using the computer lab facilities.
- 93.5% of the faculty is engaged in research work.
- 75% agreed that they are encouraging waste management practices.
- 93.18% of the teachers agreed that the Head of the institution is approachable.
- 86.36% of the faculty opined that there is a significant representation given to the faculty in all the academic/administrative activities.
- 84.1% of the teachers agreed that the parents are satisfied with the faculty.
- 95.5% of the teachers opined that feedback is taken from time to time from all the stakeholders.
- 100% of the faculty maintains the documents accurately.
- 95.5% told that the staff development needs are identified and programs are initiated for the same.
- 91% opined that the capabilities of the teachers are utilized optimum.
- 95.5% of the teachers have agreed that the management provides them with incentives.
- 97.7% of the teachers agreed that an alternative arrangement of the class is made, when any of the teachers is on leave.

Parents Feedback Analysis

A questionnaire is given to the parents who attended Parent-Teacher meeting. Total 54 parents responded.

- 1. 78% of the parents visited the College.
- 2. 82% of the parents have gone through the prospectus of the college.
- 3. 51% of the parents are aware of NAAC Accreditation.
- 4. 51% of the parents' visited the college web site.
- 5. 45% of the parents visited the college website to check the attendance of their ward.
- 6. 87% of the parents know the college timings.
- 7. 78% of the parents know the dress code of the college.
- 8. 69% of the parents never meet the Faculty.
- 9. 85% of the parents are satisfied with the Teaching –Learning process offered by the college.
- 10. 82% of the parents accepted that they are receiving messages from the office.
- 11. 62% of the parents opined that they can approach authorities easily.
- 12. 74% of the parents are aware of the college events.
- 13. 45% of the parents know about the scholarships given by the staff/other sources.
- 14. 64% of the parents are aware of the cash prizes given by the college for different activities.
- 15. 67% of the parents know about Diary/Campus pulse/Magazine of the college.
- 16. 76% of the parents told that the environment of the college congenial for the students to discuss their grievances.
- 17. 80% of the parents satisfied with the in-house examination system adopted by the institution.
- 18. 51% of the parents know about guest lectures delivered by the eminent personalities in the college.

- 19. 73% of the parents know about Campus Recruitment Training (CRT) provided by the placement cell of the college.
- 20. 64% of the parents know about Add on certificate courses.
- 21. 82% of the parents are known about library facilities.
- 22. 65% of the parents are known about the activities of physical education department.
- 23. 80% of the parents are known about the Computers, Commerce and Management Labs.
- 24. 58% of the parents are aware of the extracurricular activities conducted by NCC, NSS and Eco Club.
- 25. 31% of the parents know about the activities of the Women Empowerment Cell.
- 26. 62% of the parents know that the college provides medical facilities in emergency cases.
- 27. 38% of the parents are using Right to Information Act (RTI).
- 28. 89% of the parents will refer the college to their relatives or friends.

Alumni Feedback Analysis

A questionnaire is prepared and data is collected from 41 alumni. The data is analyzed as follows:

- 70% of the respondents are the members of the alumni association
- 52.5% of the respondents are satisfied as the members of the alumni association
- 45% of the respondents are associated with the activities of the college
- 100% of the respondents are contributing to the development of college through both monetary and non-monetary.
- 82.5% of the respondents are providing financial support to the college in various facilities.
- 56% of the respondents told that they provide Guest Lectures, 22.5% told that they provide workshops and the remaining told that they provide internships to the college.
- 62.5% of the alumni collaborate with college through awareness programs and 37.5% told that they collaborate with college through other donations.
- 67.5% of the respondents opine that entrepreneurship depends on student's aptitude.

• 17.5% of respondents maintain communication through mail/ Website, 32.5% maintain through alumni association and 50% maintain through personal contacts.
