This budget proposal rests on six pillars – health and well being, physical and financial capital and infrastructure, inclusive development for aspirational India, reinvigorating human capital, innovation and R & D and minimum Government and maximum governance.

The significant aspect is that, to benefit 'Make in India', there is a slew hike in customs duty, a proposal to disinvest in few PSUs. Personal income tax slabs remain as it is in the previous budget. This budget brought in new proposals such as, PM Atmanirbhar Scheme is to be launched to develop primary, secondary and tertiary health care, launching Sainik Schools and Ekalvyas Schools, Highway Road works in Kerala, Tamilnadu, West Bengal and Assam. A Unified Securities Market Code to be created, consolidating the provisions of the SEBI Act, Depositories Act.

It is an opportunity to academicians, professionals and research scholars in contributing their research expertise on the relevance of this budget in the post pandemic scenario, its impact on the economy in general and on a common man in particular and its implications and to exchange the views of paper presenters on the pros and cons of the budget.
