Peer Review Process

- 1. All the papers received will be submitted to peer review committee.
- Each paper will be reviewed by two referees. They can be either external or members of the Advisory Board, though always chosen by their recognized expertise.
- 3. After evaluation, the reviewers will produce reports about the works reviewed, by which the papers can be
 - a) Accepted with modifications
 - b) Approved as they are
 - c) Rejected from the start
- If the paper needs modifications, the editors will return the articles, to the authors along with reviewers suggestions/comments and recommendations there in.
- 5. The final decision concerning the publication of papers belongs to the Editorial Board, having the reviewers a consultative role.
