NAAC RE-ACCREDITATION (3rd CYCLE)

National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) is an autonomous body funded by the University Grants Commission and headquartered in Bangalore, which assesses and accredits Higher Education Institutions (HEIs). It is an outcome of the recommendations of the National Policy in Education (1986) which laid special emphasis on upholding the quality of higher education in India. NAAC accreditation is generally at the institutional level, assessing the performance based on various parameters categorized into 7 criteria.

NAAC's mandate includes the task of performance evaluation, assessment and accreditation of universities and colleges in the country. The philosophy of NAAC is based on objective and continuous improvement rather than being punitive or judgmental, so that all institutions of higher learning are empowered to maximize their resources, opportunities and capabilities. An institution's "Quality Status" is primarily determined through assessment and accreditation. Higher Education Institutions (HEI) receive accreditation scores when they meet the NAAC quality standards for institutes, colleges and universities.

Indian Institute of Management and Commerce has accredited by NAAC thrice. During the first cycle in 2010, the college has secured 'B'Grade, Second cycle with 'B++' in 2017 and in third cycle secured 'A+' grade in 2023.

17. Every student must write Unit Test/Slip Test without fail. Students who do not write these tests without valid reasons will be penalized.

Parents are advised to interact with the faculty to know the progress of their wards at regular intervals and frequently visit college **website: www.iimchyderabad.com/ www.iimchyd.ac.in** They may contact the Principal/Vice-Principals, Heads of Departments and the Class Mentors for information regarding attendance and any other academic progress within the college hours.
19. Students are not authorized to collect donations from the fellow students for any of the college activity, without the permission of the Principal. On identifying any such unethical practices, action will be initiated.
20. It is mandatory for students to put not less than 75% of attendance in lectures (and practicals wherever applicable). On the specific recommendations of the Principal/Vice-Principals, the Vice-Chancellor may condone the shortage of attendance to the extent of 10% on medical grounds subject to the production of a Medical Certificate (MC) and the payment of prescribed condonation fee. less than the required attendance even after submitting the MC will not be permitted to appear for the University Examination. Every month the statement of attendance will be displayed on the notice board and uploaded on college website. Students and parents should take note of the attendance.

21. A student who is irregular to the class is liable to forfeit his claims towards (a) Scholarship (b) Concessions for Railway & Bus Pass (c) Eligibility to represent the College/University in Sports & Games and other activities (d) Participation in campus activities and (e) Rewards.
22. 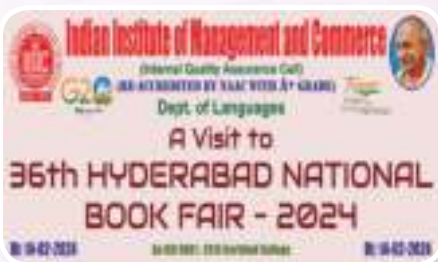

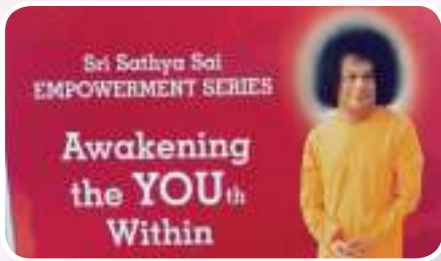

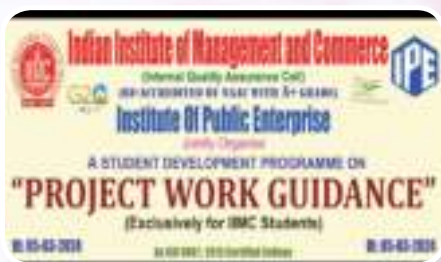
