GENERAL RULES OF THE OFFICE

1. An application should be given in the office by the students (Present or Past), for obtaining certificates (Transfer, Conduct, Bonafide, Games etc.,)
2. One day prior to the requirement of certificates, the application should be addressed to the Principal.
3. Students should bring their Identity Cards to the college every day without fail and produce it whenever asked, especially while dealing with the office, library and also for any other academic matters for authentication purpose.
4. In case of College Identity Card/Tag Lost, new Identity Card /Tag is issued by paying fine of Rs. 200.
5. All the fees must be paid by the notified due date, to avoid payment of fine.
6. Irregularity in attendance, insubordination, discourtesy to staff members, habitual inattention and late coming, neglect of work, obscenity in word or act are punishable by temporary/permanent dismissal.
7. Fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
8. All the students are instructed to read notices displayed on the notice boards everyday.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

All the students are expected to abide by the rules of the college and maintain strict discipline and order in all matters of curricular and extracurricular activities.

1. We are directed to implement **Biometric Attendance System (BAS)** for all the students from this academic year as per Osmania University guideliness and Government Order.
2. It is imperative that students must come in time and are required to be punctual and regular to the college. After 9:20 am, no student is allowed into the college premises. In this regard parents have to co-operate.
3. If the students/ parents do not respond to the notices regarding lack of required percentage of attendance, they are penalized.

4. Special conditions exist in a co- educational institution. The parents of girl students are assured that along with academic excellence, the management pays special attention towards safety and security within the college premises.
5. Insubordination, discourtesy to the staff members, habitual inattention and late coming, neglect of work, obscenity in word or act, students are punishable by temporary/permanent dismissal.
6. RAGGING in any form is strictly prohibited vide O.U Letter No.380/SWD/23/97, dated 13-7-1997. Any one indulging in ragging will be expelled from the college. The Management, Principal and staff act in unison in curbing the menace of “Ragging” by initiating activities which make the seniors and juniors mingle freely and cordially, so that the unpleasant experience of “ragging” is not to be felt by them. Fortunately students are aware of the Supreme Court order, the Government’s strict vigilance and consequences of their actions attracting the provisions of criminal law. As a precautionary measure, ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE works in the college, consists of senior faculty and senior students.
7. No student is allowed to leave the class-room without the lecturer’s permission or until the class is over. If concerned lecturer is absent, students shall not loiter around the campus. They are expected to be in the library or they can sit in the class-room for a substitutive class.
8. Students are expected to help in maintaining general cleanliness in the college. They are strictly prohibited from:
 - a) Writing on walls and furniture
 - b) Tampering of official notices on notice boards
 - c) Littering the premises
 - d) Damaging the property
9. Boys and girls are expected to conduct themselves with dignity and maturity. They should observe norms of decency, propriety and mutual respect in their inter-relationships.
10. Students are advised not to bring large sums of money or jewellery or other valuables to the college. They must be careful about their personal belongings and money. Though attempts are made to retrieve lost property, the college will take no responsibility in this matter.
11. Students are instructed not to give the college address for their personal correspondence. The college cannot take any responsibility for letters written to them. These will not be delivered personally.
12. **Students should park their vehicles (Two-wheelers) inside the college premises in allotted places only. The college has limited parking space and will not provide parking for 4-wheelers. Irrespective of parental income, they are advised to use public transport which is safe and economical.**
13. Students should accompany their parents/specified Guardian only for any academic or curricular matters. Direct telephonic conversation with Principal/Vice-Principal is not allowed. Parents should contact Principal/Vice-Principal in person with prior appointment only.
14. The college authorities may frame and issue disciplinary rules from time to time, to maintain the reputation of the college.
15. IIMC believes that self-discipline in the form of rules, which is necessary for the smooth functioning of the institution.
16. Every student must write in-house examinations without fail. Students who do not write these examinations without valid reasons will be penalized. The meritorious Students in the in-house exams will be rewarded.
17. **Parents are advised to interact with the Faculty members to know the progress of their wards at regular intervals and frequently visit college website: www.iimchyderabad.com. They may contact the Principal/Vice- Principal, Heads of Departments and the Class Mentors**

for information regarding attendance and any other academic progress within the college hours.

18. Students are not authorized to collect donations from their fellow students for any of the college activity, without the permission of the Principal. On identifying any such unethical practices, action will be initiated.
19. It is mandatory for Students to put in not less than 75% of attendance in lectures (and practicals wherever applicable). On the specific recommendation of the Principal/Vice-Principal, the Vice-Chancellor may condone the shortage of attendance to the extent of 10% on medical grounds subject to the production of a medical certificate and the payment of prescribed condonation fee. Any candidate having less than the required attendance even after submitting the Medical Certificate will not be permitted to appear for the University Examination. Every month the statement of attendance will be displayed on the notice board and uploaded on college website. Students and parents should take note of their attendance.

A student who is irregular to the class is liable to forfeit his claim towards (a) Scholarship (b) Concessions for Railway & Bus Pass (c) Eligibility to represent the college/university in sports & games and other activities (d) Participation in campus drives.

20. **Students who discontinue the course and seek TC:** Student planning to join the Course are advised to seek full information about the Course and think carefully about their aptitude and capabilities to cope with the Course. If a student wants to discontinue the course or seeks TC, the fees paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
21. Various committees are constituted to cater the needs of the students. Students are encouraged to participate in all college activities aimed at overcoming emotional and mental inhibitions.
22. Students are not permitted to leave the college except on health grounds. They should leave the college premises after the completion of their scheduled classes.
23. Cell phones must be switched off before entering the class room. If any student found using a cell phone within the class, the phone will be confiscated.
24. Students should attend classes only in the section allotted to them. Change in the section or the batch will not be permitted.
25. If a student is suffering from sickness or any long term ailment, Parents/Gaurdian should inform the Class Mentor immediately. Failing which the college authorities are not responsible for the shortage of attendance.
26. Absence of students from the classes for more than a month and also any kind of misbehavior with the staff may lead to rustication from the rolls.
27. Students are asked to check their attendance status from the notice board / website monthly and inform the Parents. Any kind of discrepancies in attendance should be brought to the notice of class mentor immediately. Failing which the college authorities are not held responsible.
28. Students are asked to pay fees within stipulated time.
29. Students are supposed to clear all the dues before the issue of hall tickets.
