1. A State Level Workshop on “How to Crack NET Paper 1” (15.11.21 – 18.11.21)

Seminars and Workshops Committee organized a Four Day State Level Workshop on “How to Crack NET Paper 1”, to make the NET/SET aspirants familiar with the tricks and tips to solve data interpretation, numerical ability, reasoning and teaching aptitude and research aptitude. Prof. Anthony Patrick, Director of Admissions, OUCC & BM, O.U. taught teaching & research aptitude and data interpretation, first two days. The second two days, Sri. Vijaya Saradhi, Asst.
