The unprecedenced changes in the Information technology and dynamic crosscultural environment, have influenced the student community, their aspirations, preferences, priorities and attitude towards Life, Work, World, Self and Others around them.

We find the students study habits have undergone a considerable change, reflected in reduced visitsto libraries, a general attitude of indifference towards various things. While the job markets are expanding in private sector, the students search for Government jobs. All such confusions arise due to lack of proper guidance and reduced importance of regularity of attendance in the colleges.
