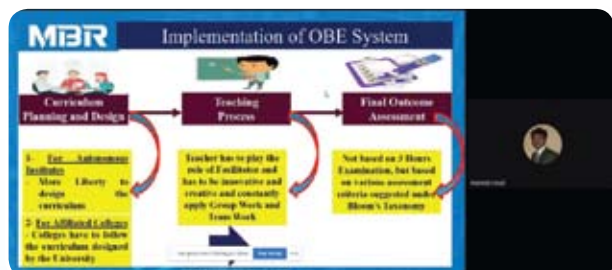
28. Clean India Campaign (28.10.2021)

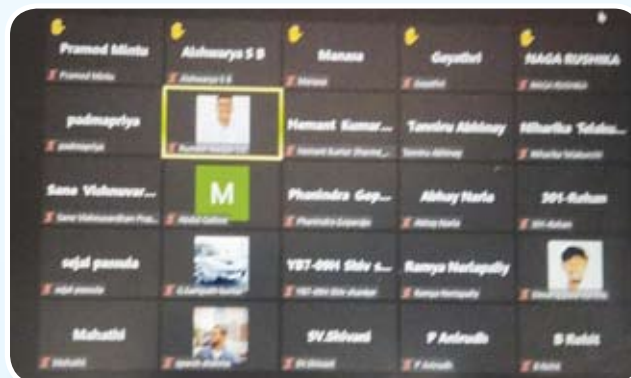
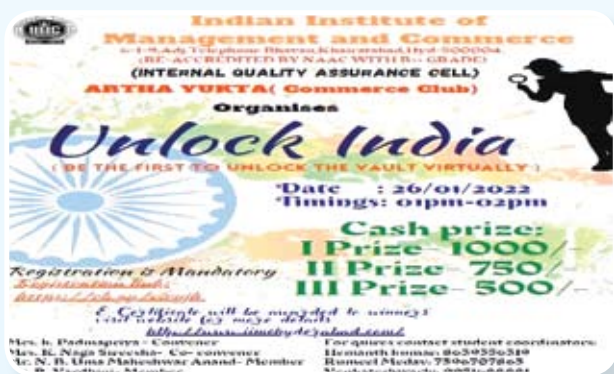
92. Republic Day Celebrations (26-1- 2022)

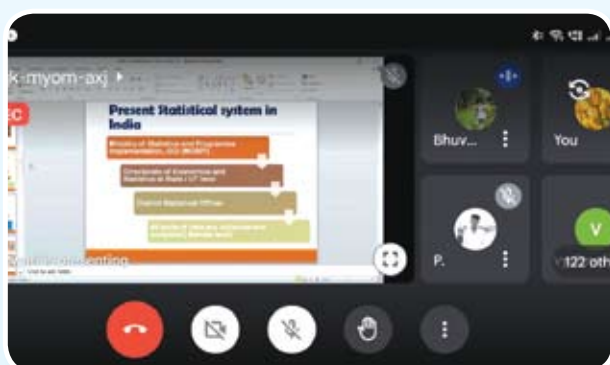
96. ATC Camp 5-2-2022

99. Effective Public Speaking (10-2-22 to 12-2-22)

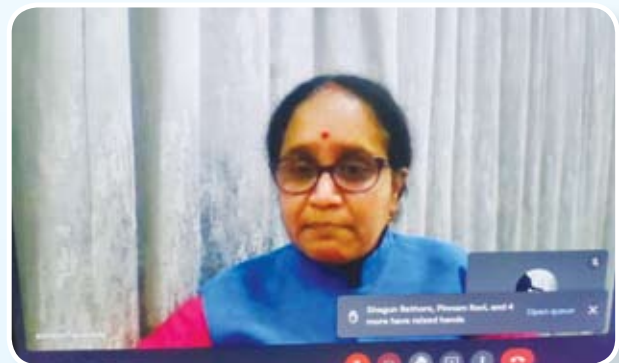

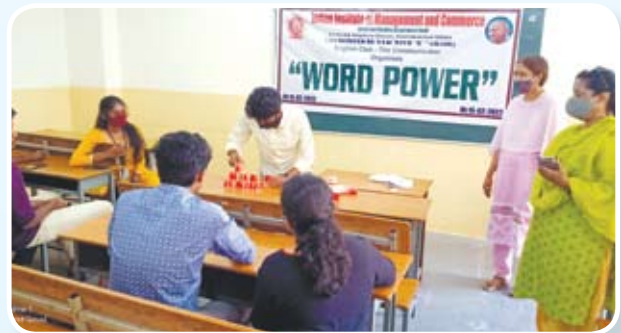
103. NCC Unit Officer Visit (15-2-2022)

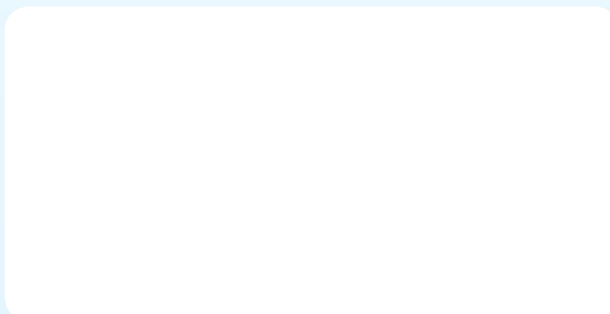


107. ICICI Prudential Life Insurance Virtual Recruitment Drive (19-02-2022)

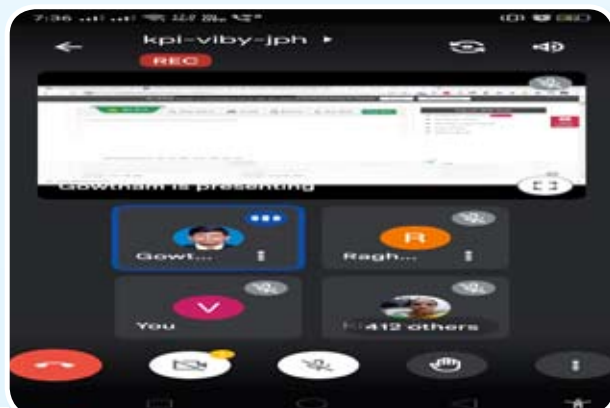
128. Sri Rama Navami Utsavalu - 'Raghuvamsa Charitaamrutam' (9-4-2022)
